

MoCRA: Modernization of Cosmetics Regulation Act of 2022

In December 2022, the **Modernization of Cosmetics Regulation Act (MoCRA)** was signed into law, the most significant update to U.S. cosmetic regulation since 1938. It expands the **FDA's authority** to ensure cosmetic safety and impacts formulators, manufacturers, and brand owners.

Key Requirements

- Facility Registration Manufacturers/processors must register with FDA and renew every 2 years. (see small business exemption)
- Adverse Event Reporting Serious reactions must be reported within 15 days.
- FDA Records Access FDA may inspect company records and facilities.
- Ingredient Listing Submit and update annually with FDA.
- Recalls FDA can mandate recalls if a product is unsafe.
- VCRP Discontinued New FDA registration system pending.

Labeling Essentials

- Must include responsible party's legal business name and contact info (no P.O. boxes).
- Acceptable consumer contact: phone, email, or website.
- FTC enforces truth in advertising—claims must be accurate and non-misleading.
- Principal Display Panel (PDP): Follow font size and placement rules.
- **Safety Substantiation:** Back product safety with data, COAs, IFRA certificates, and stability/microbial testing.
- **Ingredient Declaration:** List ingredients in proper order, use INCI names, disclose blends, fragrance, botanicals, and net weight.

GMP & Recordkeeping

- Ingredient tracking, lot numbers, and batch records required.
- FDA will establish mandatory Good Manufacturing Practices (GMPs)

Small Business Exemption

Exemption applies if sales are under \$1M (3 consecutive years), except for:

- Injectables
- Ingestible cosmetics
- Long-lasting cosmetics (e.g., lashes, nails)
- Products contacting the eye's mucous membrane

Upcoming FDA Actions (2025+)

- PFAS Report Safety assessment due Dec. 29, 2025.
- **GMP Standards** FDA will issue detailed regulations.
- **Asbestos in Talc** Standardized testing methods coming.
